- He will celebrate Mass at St. Thomas Church at 6:00 pm, welcoming parishioners, school families, and the wider community to join together for this special liturgy.







- Sunday, November 24:

  - 11:00 am: Feast Day Celebration of St. Leonard of Port Maurice, beginning with the blessing of the relic of St. Leonard, followed by Mass and a light lunch in the spirit of community and fellowship.





### Sunday's readings

### **Entrance Antiphon**

Jeremiah 29:11,12,14

The Lord said: I think thoughts of peace and not of affliction. You will call upon me, and I will answer you, and I will lead back your captives from every place.

### First Reading Daniel 12:1-3

At that time Michael will stand up, the great prince who mounts guard over your people. There is going to be a time of great distress, unparalleled since nations first came into existence. When that time comes, your own people will be spared, all those whose names are found written in the Book. Of those who lie sleeping in the dust of the earth many will awake, some to everlasting life, some to shame and everlasting disgrace. The learned will shine as brightly as the vault of heaven, and those who have instructed many in virtue, as bright as stars for all eternity.

### Responsorial Psalm Ps 15:5. 8-11. R.v.1 (R.) Keep me safe, O God: you are my hope.

- 1.O Lord, it is you who are my portion and cup; it is you yourself who are my prize. I keep the Lord ever in my sight; since he is at my right hand, I shall stand firm. (R.)
- 2.And so my heart rejoices, my soul is glad; even my body shall rest in safety. For you will not leave my soul among the dead, nor let your beloved know decay. (R.)

### Second Reading Hebrews 10:11-14, 18

All the priests stand at their duties every day, offering over and over again the same sacrifices which are quite incapable of taking sins away. Christ, on the other hand, has offered one single sacrifice for sins, and then taken his place for ever, at the right hand of God, where he is now waiting until his enemies are made into a footstool for him. By virtue of that one single offering, he has achieved the eternal perfection of all whom he is sanctifying. When all sins have been forgiven, there can be no more sin offerings.

### Gospel Mark 13:24-32

Jesus said to his disciples: 'In those days, after the time of distress, the sun will be darkened, the moon will lose its brightness, the stars will come falling from heaven and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. And then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory; then too he will send the angels to gather his chosen from the four winds, from the ends of the world to the ends of heaven.

Take the fig tree as a parable: as soon as its twigs grow supple and its leaves come out, you know that summer is near. So with you, when you see these things happening: know that he is near, at the very gates. I tell you solemnly, before this generation has passed away all these things will have taken place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.

'But as for that day or hour, nobody knows it, neither the angels of heaven, nor the Son; no one but the Father.'

The Diocese of Broken Bay is once again supporting RED Wednesday 2024, an initiative of Aid to the Church in Need (ACN), to pray for and support Christians around the world who suffer and are persecuted for their faith.

Our Lady of Dolours, Chatswood, will be flooded in red light on Wednesday 20th November, when Bishop Anthony Randazzo will celebrate Mass at 7.00 pm, sharing the bond which unites us all in love and solidarity with our brothers and sisters in so many regions of the world who suffer and are persecuted for their love of Jesus Christ. Everyone is welcome to the Mass.

Since 2018, ACN Australia has joined global commemorations for RED Wednesday. The Diocese of Broken Bay has participated in recent years with Mass and prayerful support at Our Lady of Dolours, Chatswood.

The façade of Our Lady of Dolours will be bathed in red light from Monday, 18th November, through to Friday, 22nd November.

Aid to the Church in Need is the only international charity dedicated to the suffering of Christians wherever they are persecuted, oppressed or in pastoral need.

Almost 340 million Christians around the world – or 1 in every 7 people - cannot freely exercise their faith or live in a country where they suffer some form of persecution and oppression for their love of Jesus Christ.

According to a report from ACN released last month, persecution is only getting worse throughout the world. Red Wednesday presents an opportunity to offer our prayers and financial support to those who face persecution for their faith.

We hope many people from across the Diocese will be able to join together on Red Wednesday, to unite in prayer for our Christian brothers and sisters across the globe.
